

**Private Thomas George Yoell M2/189877** Army Service Corps died on 24/11/1918 aged 39 and is buried in Busigny Communal Cemetery Extension.

He was the son of Edwin and Charlotte Yoell, of Carolgate, Retford, Notts; husband of Edith Caroline Seymour or Yoell, of The Bungalow, Horsemoor Green, Langley, Bucks. whom he married in 1907. He was an Estate Agent in Eton
